

Arrive at CTEC starting @ 7:20am (Breakfast is available)


Students should NOT be arriving before 7:20 am. They will not be allowed in building.





Attendance is part of your daily grade. If you are absent you get a zero on your daily rubric. If you bring in a note within 2 days, the zero changes to an X. It does not count for or against you.

CTEC accepts **5 written notes from a parent/guardian.** Other notes can be from a medical provider, etc.

Family vacations are not documented or considered excused. Do not assume your home school will send us the note you turned in to them, we need you to turn in a note to your instructor at CTEC.

Attendance

Attendance is *VERY* important at CTEC! Shop work is difficult to make up

You are allowed *5 parent* notes a year Parents can call and leave a message, but a note is still required

Doctor notes are preferred

If you are absent, bring in a note to both schools within 48 hours to make up the work

No note results in a ZERO for the day

Home school closings are excused Delays, Field Trips, MCAS, Mrs. Zapor communicates with home schools


